The season of Pentecost is among us, and on Sunday I continued preaching through the book of Acts. In Acts 4, Luke reiterates part of the passage that I shared with all of you on graduate Sunday from Acts 2.

32 All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of their possessions was their own, but they shared everything they had. 33 With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all 34 that there were no needy persons among them. For from time to time those who owned land or houses sold them, brought the money from the sales 35 and put it at the apostles' feet, and it was distributed to anyone who had need.

36 Joseph, a Levite from Cyprus, whom the apostles called Barnabas (which means "son of encouragement"), 37 sold a field he owned and brought the money and put it at the apostles' feet.

In the Link on Sunday we prayed over an act of service that our Wynnton Kids participated in during their Sunday School experience. They packed blessing bags which will be given to ANYONE who comes to our church seeking assistance. The bags are simple, they meet basic needs of hunger and thirst. But it joins our work as the Church to see no needy among us.

As a father of three I am so deeply grateful to everyone who has stepped up to serve in our relaunched children's ministries, I am personally seeing how God is using the leaders of those ministries to shape our children, and I am delighted that they are leading us in this way. Thanks be to God!




