Well, in case you missed it, during Sunday's virtual worship service, we announced that the leadership of our church has decided to postpone, temporarily, our reopening for in-person worship in the sanctuary. This decision was made out of an abundance of caution surrounding recent trends in the spread of COVID-19 in our community and a close encounter a member of our staff has had with the virus. We will continue to monitor this situation closely with a desire to move forward with our reopening plan as quickly as possible.

While I share your disappointment with this decision and what it means for being able to worship together, in person, again, I am so thankful to be surrounded by people like our very own Diana Boensel who offered the following perspective on this situation:

As the wife of a Navy Band member, I had the opportunity to experience some incredible music. I also learned some of the favored acronyms and mottos of the various bands my husband served with. The unofficial motto of the Navy music program, "Semper Gumby", or "Always Flexible", seems particularly appropriate as we plan and prepare to worship together in person. "Semper Gumby" (which refers to the stretchy, pliable little green dude many of us played with as children) means that while you might show up to a gig to play saxophone and end up playing bass drum – still, the show will go on. So, while reopening the church for worship may be delayed for safety reasons, if we also adopt an attitude of Semper Gumby we will remember that

Love is not postponed Hope is not postponed Music is not postponed God is not postponed!

We will worship together again in person. What a day of rejoicing that will be! There is comfort in knowing that some things are unchanging.
