Last week our Finance Ministry Team met to hear the final numbers for 2018 and get an update for 2019. I want to share these with you.

Giving for the year 2018 \$904,570.55

Note: This includes income from all sources and a wonderful December, in which, \$146,561.44 was given. This represents 99.34% of the 2018 budget.

Expenses for the year 2018 \$891,330.74

Note: This represents 97.89% of the 2018 Budget

Net gain for 2018 \$13,239.31

Note: This is wonderful, since at one point we were \$60,000 behind. You really came through when we let you know where we stood. Thanks so much!
