WYNNTON NEIGHBORHOOD NETWORK

Our mission is to provide an emergency source of food for people in temporary need. Of the families we served last year, two thirds came to us only once for help. Another 21% came to us a second time, while 7% came to us three times and only 5% came all four times we allow per year.

Last year was a record year for the Network. Thanks to your extraordinary generosity we were able to meet the food needs of 4,550 families during the year. Those families contained 11,900 people including 5,450 children. We also assisted 475 families in keeping their lights and heat on and spent about \$32,000.

This year is starting out with very high demand for our services as well. Please continue to remember us in the coming year.
